Did You Know?

You can access around 5000 online journals from the library website. Some of these have been bought nationally for all NHS staff, some we subscribe to locally. Most cover clinical subjects but there are some more general journals as well. More unusual titles include 'The Lamp', the journal of the New South Wales Nurses Association and 'The Futurist', a magazine discussing future trends. Recent issues include articles on 'Microbots' and on imagining the future from science fiction.

- **What is UpToDate?**
UpToDate is a Point of Care resource allowing rapid access to detailed clinical summaries of medical and surgical conditions, together with treatment and drug options, graphics and patient information.

- **An enhanced mobility strategy for organisations**
Access UpToDate Mobile Apps can be used on most mobile devices.
- **CME/CE/CPD credits accrued onsite or remotely.**
If you log in you will accrue credit when researching a clinical

question using **UpToDate Anywhere**, either on-site or via a mobile device.
