For anyone needing to do detailed literature searches, Healthcare Database Advanced Search (HDAS) is the site to use. HDAS now has a simpler search profile than its previous versions and many new features. You can find it as before on the [NICE Evidence Search](#) website. You will need an NHS Athens account to access most of the databases on the site. You will be able to link to any article where the library has online access. Find HDAS on our [library website](#), under 'Resources Access'. Don't forget to book a library training session for HDAS if you've not used it before.

New SWiFT Search *.....search (almost) all our resources in one place.*

The Library has introduced our new 'SWiFT Search' facility. Powered by Ebsco Discovery Service the new search engine searches most of the library's resources with one search. Go to our website, SWiFT search is available on the home page and also the 'Resources Access' column. Type in a search-term, and SWiFT will look in:

- ✎ Library Catalogue
- ✎ Major Databases (including Medline & Cinahl)
- ✎ Full-text online journals and free resources online.



You can limit your search to retrieve only full-text online articles, books, magazines or many more types of publication. Search a range of dates of your choice. Further limits allow you to search different subjects within your topic or choose material published in the United Kingdom. You can extend your searches to *NICE Evidence Search*, *UpToDate* and the *Trip Database* using the same terms. In addition to library resources SWiFT Search will find many items freely available on the internet, including articles, books, university dissertations etc. Subjects outside of medicine and health will be found, making SWiFT Search useful for social science, current affairs and more. Advanced and Boolean searching is available.

Come to the library any time we are staffed in May or June for a demonstration.

NEW 2018 Charges for articles & books

We have changed the charging arrangements for obtaining articles and books from other libraries.

From April 2018, we won't charge for supplying articles unless we are directly charged by the library which supplies us. That means we can send it to you as a PDF and there will be no need to come to the library to collect those articles.

A small number of national institutions do make a charge to us. For these we will charge **£3.00 (£5.00 for students)**. Articles supplied by the British Library cannot be forwarded as PDFs. These we must print out and will need to be collected from the library or sent by internal post.

We still subsidise the cost and it's worth remembering that articles downloaded from publishers' websites can be as much as \$35.00 each. We will always inform you if there will be a charge. Occasionally, for obscure or foreign material or university dissertations, there may be additional charges. We will discuss these with you before ordering.

Due to the cost of borrowing books we have now put this up to **£7.00 (£10.00 for students)**.

.....if we can download the article or get it from another NHS library we will supply it free.

We will need payment before we can send the articles & books to you.



- **Book Loans** All students can now borrow books from the other Coventry & Warwickshire NHS libraries—see 'New Books' item for more details.
